PROJECT DESCRIPTION

PSU had to engage in a large-scale legacy reporting solution including deployment and significant business process changes. An increased need for transparency demanded that information silos be removed and a culture of data stewardship replace a culture of data ownership. Ensuring a single vision of the information required standardized reporting environments including the deployment of an enterprise-wide system that effectively supported PSU, integrating related processes across multiple departments, eliminating shadow systems, paper, and duplicate data entry, clarifying staff roles, providing expanded training, and simplifying and standardizing processes for long-term growth.
